Bright Ideas

Huge windows surround the roomy saloon, brightening it with natural light and unfettered views. The airy space has an L-shaped settee that's convertible to a guest berth and an open galley with a full-size fridge for fresh provisions.



Steering Committee

The pilothouse has a double helm seat and a double companion seat opposite, making for plenty of company for the skipper. Doors grant easy access to the wide side decks making single-handed docking easier.



Room to Share

The saloon has a homey, great-room feel and comfortable finish. It sits just three steps down from the pilothouse, and because it's nearby, the yacht's whole crew can easily stay connected.





Forecast: Showers

The design of the owner's en suite reflects the needs of a cruising couple who may be at sea for extended times: An athwartships arrangement for the head compartment creates a dedicated space and a standup shower.

The owner's stateroom features a walkaround queen berth, a large hanging locker, and an athwartships head arrangement with a standing shower. Stowage capacity on board easily meets the 365's coastal-cruising mission.
